***DISCOUNT PRESCRIPTION DRUG CARDS AVAILABLE FOR  
WILKES-BARRE CITY RESIDENTS MONDAY, MAY 18***

**WILKES-BARRE** – Mayor Thomas M. Leighton announces that Wilkes-Barre City residents may pick up free discount prescription drug cards at multiple city locations beginning on Monday, May 18. The card program, which is sponsored by the National League of Cities, is designed to help residents save money on prescriptions that are not covered by insurance and can offer an average savings of 20 percent off retail prices.

Cards will be available in the following Wilkes-Barre City locations:

- Health Department, located in the Kirby Health Center at 71 North Franklin Street
- Tax and Code Offices, located on the first floor of Wilkes-Barre City Hall, 40 East Market Street
- Mayor's Office, located on the fourth floor of Wilkes-Barre City Hall, 40 East Market Street

Please note that there are no age or income restrictions, as well as no limit on the number of times the card can be used. One card can be used by all family members.

Currently, the cards may be used by all residents at the following Wilkes-Barre pharmacies: Rite Aid Pharmacies at 35 Public Square and 155 East Northampton Street, General Community Pharmacy at 110 South Pennsylvania Avenue, Caresite Pharmacy at 175 South Wilkes-Barre Boulevard, CVS Pharmacy at 351 South Main Street, The Medicine Shoppe at 395 South Main Street, Bedwick's Pharmacy at 452 Hazle Street, Harrold's Pharmacy at 179 Old River Road, Keystone Professional Pharmacy at 53 Gravel Street and Sheehan's Pharmacy at 79 East Carey Avenue.
